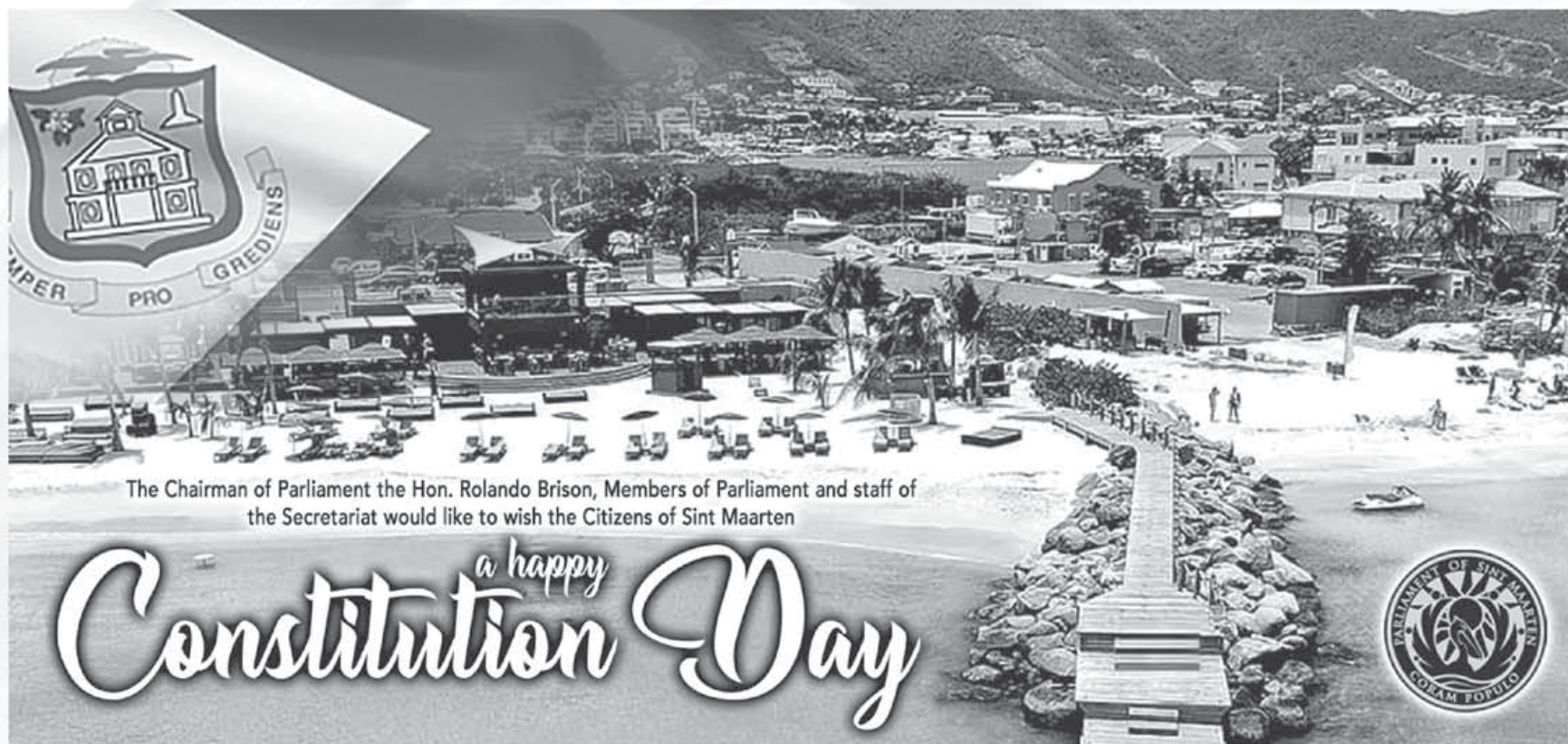
CAZ 02 – Wednesday, September 30, 2020
