Who are we?

The Financial Intelligence Unit is an operationally independent Service within the Ministry of Justice. The general objective of the organization is to maintain the integrity of the financial system by effectively preventing and combating money laundering, financing of terrorism and proliferation and the predicate crimes.

Who are we looking for?

As an Operational Analyst you are responsible for, among other things:

- a. Collecting, registering and conducting investigations into reported unusual (financial) transactions based on the applicable laws and regulations in the field of combating money laundering and terrorist financing and proliferation;
- b. processing requests for information from Law Enforcement Authorities;
- c. exchanging information with foreign Financial Intelligence Units.
