Who are we?
The Ministry of Justice aims to create preconditions for the maintenance of security, order and tranquility, and the safeguarding of justice within society. The organization of the Ministry the staff bureau, the Judicial Affairs Department, and the following executive organizations: the St. Maarten Police Force, the Prison Service, the Immigration and Border Protection Service, the National Criminal Investigation Department, Customs, and the Unusual Transactions Reporting Point. The Coast Guard, as well as the judiciary and the Public Prosecutor's Office, serve other countries within the Kingdom besides Sint Maarten and are regulated by so-called consensus Kingdom laws. The Secretary General is the highest official position in the ministry. This official is responsible for the substantive and organizational management of the ministry. The politically responsible and highest executive is the Minister of Justice.

The position
As Head Controller, you will oversee the financial administration and have many responsibilities. Your duties will include audit work, budget and financial statements, and contributing to the development and direction of the Planning and control cycles.

The Controller makes decisions in making analyses and conducting investigations, in advising management on improvements and priorities, in monitoring the coherence of the business and information processes within the organizational section, in drawing up the (multi-year) budget and indicating alternatives, and in directing the development and implementation of the P&C cycle; performing investigations and audits, to assess the legality, efficiency and effectiveness of (proposed) (policy) products and you recognize and analyze (financial) risks, draw up regulations and guidelines, make recommendations to improve internal processes and monitor their implementation and compliance. You contribute to the preparation of management contracts and SLAs and coordinate management reports.

Job requirements
You have a University or College degree in Business Economics and or Finance with at least 5 years of work experience and in-depth knowledge of integral planning and control cycle and business operations. You are a driven and flexible colleague with a broad financial background in policy-based work. You are strongly analytical and can express yourself both orally and in writing in Dutch and English.

The offer
In principle, this is an appointment for one (1) or three (3) years with the prospect of a permanent position. The salary depends on knowledge and experience and is at the level of maximum scale 13 (Ang. 11,128.00). If you reside outside St. Maarten, relocation-related expenses will be reimbursed according to the applicable policy. Land children are preferred.

MANDATORY BUSINESS CLOSURE AND EXEMPTION FOR SHOPS IN PHILIPSBURG ON ST. MAARTEN'S DAY (NOVEMBER 11, 2025), CHRISTMAS DAY (DECEMBER 25, 2025), AND NEW YEAR'S DAY (JANUARY 1, 2026)

The public is herewith reminded that November 11th, 2025 (St. Maarten's Day), December 25th, 2025 (Christmas Day), and January 1st, 2026 (New Year's Day) are official public holidays.

In accordance with the National Ordinance on Shop Closure (*Landsverordening winkelsluiting*, AB 2013, GT no. 542), all places of business, including all stand-alone casinos and lottery establishments must be closed on these days.

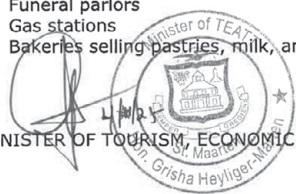
The Minister of Tourism, Economic Affairs, Traffic, and Telecommunication (TEATT) hereby informs the public that, due to the number of cruise ships that are scheduled to visit our port on St. Maarten's Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day, an exemption is granted to allow shops in Philipsburg to operate and be open between 6:00 AM and 6:30 PM on November 11th, 2025, December 25th, 2025, and on January 1st, 2026.

This decision is intended to enhance the visitor experience and to support our economic activity during the holiday season.

Businesses opting to operate under this exemption are reminded to comply fully with all applicable labor regulations.

The aforementioned does not apply to the following businesses that may continue to operate as is regulated in article 3 of the National Ordinance on Shop Closure (*Landsverordening winkelsluiting*, AB 2013, GT no. 542)

- Pharmacies, as long as it concerns the sale of medicine and medical products
- Bars and restaurants
- Hotels and guesthouses
- Stores located in hotels, on the airport and on the harbor premises.
- Funeral parlors
- Gas stations
- Bakeries selling pastries, milk, and/or milk products
