WE ARE HIRING AMBULANCE DISPATCHER



The Ambulance Department is seeking an enthusiastic, dynamic, and well-rounded professional in the field to serve as an Ambulance Dispatcher

Core tasks/responsibilities:

As a switchboard operator at the Ambulance Dispatch Center Sint Maarten, you work within a lively and dynamic region and are confronted with a wide variety of (acute) medical emergency requests. In this position it goes without saying that you are a good listener, can keep asking questions and can quickly decide whether the deployment of an ambulance is necessary

In addition, you will coordinate the emergency services in which the transport of the patient is in the foreground. Here, care and customer orientation are central. Besides urgent requests for ambulance transport, you plan non-urgent trips, and you take care of the distribution and readiness of ambulances on the island. As an ambulance dispatcher you have a coordinating and indicative role within ambulance care, and you function as a pivot between the emergency caller and ambulance staff or other emergency workers. In doing so, you are a question box and counselor, providing guidance and direction.

Main tasks:

- You conduct reporting interviews, interpret and assess how best to meet the request for help;
- You are responsible for the correct, effective and efficient entry into the medical care process of an applicant for help and determine the indication for this;
- You will professionally handle the telephone intake, indication and processing of reports (via 911, GPS, hospitals);
- You take care of the planning and allocation of (acute) care;
- You direct ambulances operationally and participate in the practical implementation of emergency assistance;
- You alert emergency responders and in cooperation initiate the scaling-up procedure.

Qualifications:

Knowledge and skills:

- You have an MBO education and thinking and working level, in a medical or healthcare field or completed training in the field of EMT-B; Emergency Medical Dispatch;
- You have good communication, oral and written skills and are well versed digitally;
- You have a flexible, empathetic and stable personality;
- You are careful and can handle confidential information;
- You are willing to undergo initial training to become an EMT-B.
- Salary will depend on education and experience and range between a minimum of Cg 2,294.00 and a maximum of Cg 4,345.00 gross
