Terms of Reference (TOR) for hiring external legal advisory services

The Ministry of Public Housing, Spatial Planning, Environment and Infrastructure (VROMI) hereby invites qualified legal professionals or law firms to submit proposals for the provision of external legal advisory and representation services.

The purpose of this engagement is to strengthen the Ministry's legal capacity, ensure compliance with the legal framework of Sint Maarten, support institutional continuity, and facilitate the effective implementation of the Ministry's legislative and policy mandate.

The selected legal professional or firm will, on an "as-needed" basis, provide legal representation, advisory services, and assistance to the Ministry. This includes, but is not limited to, matters where the regular Government Attorney is unable to represent the Country and/or the Ministry.

The initial engagement period will be one (1) year, with the possibility of renewal subject to satisfactory performance and evolving institutional needs.

Core tasks & responsibilities consist of the following, but are not limited to:

- Providing legal representation, advice, and assistance to ensure that the Ministry operates fully within the legal framework of Sint Maarten.
- Handling selected court cases on behalf of the Ministry where representation by the regular Government Attorney is not feasible.
- Assisting with the development, review, and revision of legislative instruments, including National Ordinances and National Decrees.
- Providing legislative drafting expertise and/or oversight of legislative projects as required by departments within the Ministry.
- Preparing written legal opinions and advice on complex legal matters.
- Drafting, reviewing, and advising on legal documents and agreements.

Knowledge and skills for our preferred candidate:

The successful candidate will be a senior legal professional or firm with expertise in public administration, infrastructure, environmental law, and other relevant legal areas. Proven experience in providing legal services to governmental institutions or comparable public sector entities. Strong analytical, drafting, and advisory skills. Demonstrated ability to handle complex legal matters independently and professionally.

Hours and rates:

The appointment is based on a 40-hour working week. The applicable salary range for this position is between XCG 6,185.00 (minimum) and XCG 9,011.00 (maximum), depending on knowledge, experience, availability, and hours worked. In addition, individual arrangements can be made based on the complexity of the work, the achievement of agreed deliverables, and measurable results.
