Description of works:

- Maintenance of the collective collection locations;
- Collection of stray garbage along main roads
- Placement of collective collection bins;
- Informing the public of pickup schedules;
- Initiate and/or participate in public awareness campaigns upon instruction of the Principal;
- Monthly submission of a report on works executed.

FEE for Tender documents. Cg. 360.00 (three hundred and sixty guilders) has to be paid by all participants in advance at the Receiver's Office. On receipt of the proof of payment receipt, the tender documents will be emailed electronically to the respective participant. The documents will be available as of the **Friday, December 19th, 2025** up until Tender date.


An information meeting regarding the tender will be held at the office of the Ministry of VROMI, Department of Infrastructure Management, Soualiga Boulevard # 1, Philipsburg, St. Maarten on **Wednesday, January 7th, 2026**.

The minutes of the information meeting and memorandum of amendments will be provided to the meeting attendees by means of email at least business 7 days before tender date.

The tender date: bids must be submitted, in a closed envelope at the office of the Ministry of VROMI, Department of Infrastructure Management, Soualiga Boulevard # 1, Philipsburg, St. Maarten on **Wednesday, January 28th, 2025**. On the date and time mentioned in the tender announcement, the doors to the tender hall will be closed at **10:00am** thus all participants should be present and submit their bids prior to this time. Envelopes will be opened and bids will be announced during the tender session. The envelope has to be clearly marked: "St. Maarten Solid Waste Collection Services 2026-2029".

When tendering, all documents stated in the Tender Document and in the minutes of the information meeting, must be submitted in order to qualify.
