Controller (Financial)

Security Officer

- Ensures the safety and security of people and property in and around the building in accordance with regulations;
- Controls access for visitors and staff, and denies entry to unauthorized individuals;
- Monitors fire alarms, security alarms, and technical systems;
- Opens and locks the building;
- Serves as the point of contact for fire, security, or technical incidents;
- Provides access to the building outside of regular office hours;
- Directs visitors to the appropriate staff, department, or service.
