### Reminder: 2025 Income Tax Returns Due June 1, 2026

The Inspectorate of Taxes announces that the deadline to submit the 2025 Income Tax Return Forms A & B is June 1, 2026. Invitations are being sent by mail; taxpayers who do not receive one are still required to file the 2025 Income Tax Return Form.

Tax return forms are available at [www.tax.sx](http://www.tax.sx) under the 'Documents' tab or via the Government's online services portal. Extensions must be requested individually before the deadline, and spouses should submit one joint tax return form.

Completed forms must be submitted at the Tax Administration Front Office (Vineyard Building), as email submissions are not permitted.
